Mother Veronica of the Passion Foundress of the Apostolic Carmel







Mother Veronica nee Sophie Leeves was born in 1823 in a pious, cultured English Anglican family. She was gifted with singular talents of mind and heart which were nurtured by sound education and wide travel.

In 1850, she embraced the Catholic faith and then responded generously to the call to religious life. She entered the Congregation of the Sisters of St Joseph of the Apparition in 1851, taking the name, Sister Mary Veronica of the Passion.

In 1862, she was sent to found a house of the Congregation at Calicut, India and there discovered an inner call to found a teaching Congregation of Active Carmelites to serve the need of faith formation through education of young girls of the West Coast of India. After facing many difficulties she founded the Apostolic Carmel at Bayonne, France in 1868 herself having first entered the Carmel of Pau, France.

The First group of sisters trained by her came to India in 1870 and were established in the Diocese of Mangalore. Circumstances forced her to re- enter the Carmel of Pau. She lived there a holy life of loving surrender to God until her death in 1906. She has been declared 'Venerable' by His Holiness Pope Francis on July 7, 2014. "A generous person will be blessed a hundred times". Her life of generous sacrifice and prayer has indeed borne abundant fruit.

Today the Congregation that she founded has grown into a mighty tree and the sisters of the Apostolic Carmel run hundreds of educational institutions not only in India but also in Sri Lanka, Pakistan, Kuwait, Bahrain, Africa and Rome. Her vision that "God Alone Suffices" has been kept afresh and green in the hearts of thousands of students through the joyful and dedicated service of the sisters in the field of Education. Her life becomes an example for us, to follow in her footsteps, to offer one's life in service of God and humanity, especially to the youth and the less privileged.

The beginnings of Carmel School go back to the 1940s. In 1946 during the Post-Independence era, the Government adopted the policy of imparting education in the regional language. Some parents in the locality of St Ann's were desirous of getting English education for their children. An arrangement was made at St Ann's Convent to teach English to pre-schoolers in an informal set up. As this 'English School' gained in popularity, the Management decided to open an English Medium School in 1951 calling it Carmel English School. In 1964 it was recognized by the Education Department and got official approval for Standard One to Five. Permanent recognition up to Standard Seven was granted by the Department of Education in 1975-76.

Carmel School is a Christian Minority Educational Institution as per the Constitution of India, Article No.30 (1) and is affiliated to the Central Board of Secondary Education (CBSE), Ministry of Human Resource Development, Government of India, Delhi with Affiliation No. 830592.

Carmel School has the required permission from the Department of Education, Government of Karnataka to run a Central School.

Our Lady of Mount Carmel-our Mother Mary-is the Patroness of Carmel School. She is a model to the Staff and the Students of going out in loving service and moving forward with determination. Our Motto 'Ever Onward' is a call to the students for an onward march in an age of Science and Technology. We strive to reach the height, the goal of sound education through Prayer and Academic Excellence, while at the same time making value based upright choices in the face of positive challenges and negative influences of the present society.

REQUIREMENTS FOR ADMISSION

- 1. Every candidate for admission must be introduced in person and withdrawal by a letter from one who is responsible for him/ her to the Principal.
- 2. Pupils coming from other Secondary Schools and Primary Schools should produce the "Transfer Certificate" issued by the Head of the School concerned, along with the Birth Certificate.
- Applications for admission should be made in the prescribed form which can be obtained from the office and should be submitted along with the Transfer Certificate from the school last attended. Every pupil on admission, shall pay the prescribed fees.
- 4. The Application for Admission must be signed by the father or mother or in their absence by a guardian who has been authorized by the parents to do so. This letter of authorization must be filed with the admission form.
- 5. In the case of admission of pupils coming from Primary Schools or Secondary Schools, the date of birth as furnished in the Transfer Certificate will be taken as correct. In the case of pupils to be newly admitted, the correct date of birth should be furnished in the application for admission and necessary documentary evidence must also be produced.
- 6. Students belonging to SC/ST should submit a photocopy of the Caste Certificate at the time of admission.
- 7. Overseas students need to counter sign their transfer certificate by the embassy of India.
- 8. The Progress Report of the child designating her academic performance and involvement in co-curricular activities in the school last attended must be submitted.

- Perfect silence should be maintained during the BELL for SILENCE and for PRAYER.
- The students must come to school clean and tidy.
 The uniform should be clean and ironed. Skirts must be tailored just below knee length. Black or Blue Tights to be worn by all girl students compulsorily.
- 3. Nails must be well pared, not coloured.
- 4. Girls with long hair should plait them neatly using black hair-clips or hair-bands or ribbons only. Decorative items like ornaments, bangles, expensive watches, etc. are discouraged as they go against the very objective of school uniform. Boys must have a proper haircut/clean shave at all times. Low waist pants for boys are forbidden.

- The prescribed foot wear from Monday to Saturday is black shoes with brown socks. However, black rainy shoes without socks are allowed during the rainy season from June to September.
- 6. When a teacher enters and exits from the class-room, the students are expected to stand respectfully in silence. The classes will commence and end with a silent prayer.
- 7. Pupils are expected to co-operate in keeping the premises of the school neat and tidy and therefore refrain from scribbling on the walls, furniture and scattering bits of paper. Any damage done within the school premises must be compensated by the one who does it.
- 8. The class leaders and deputy leaders shall render their smiling service with obedience whenever needed, in and outside the premises.
- 9. No student shall leave the classroom without the permission of the concerned teacher.
- 10. Any pupil found loitering in the school premises shall be seriously dealt with.
- 11. During off-hours, whether before or after school hours, during the short break or during the long recess, pupil's behavior will be subject to appraisal and correction.
- 12. Irregular attendance, neglecting of home assignments, disobedience and disrespect towards members of the staff or bad moral influence justify dismissal. Pupils are responsible to the school authorities for their conduct both in and outside the school.
- 13. Textbooks and notebooks should be covered neatly.
- 14. In order to acquire good command of the English language which is the medium of instruction for all the subjects, children should speak only in English in the school premises.
- 15. There will be occasional checking of bags by the teachers.

- 16. With regard to conduct, pupils of the school shall always bear in mind the good name of the institution.
- 17. Any kind of disobedience towards teachers or school authorities will be dealt seriously.
- 18. No monetary collection for any purpose will be made in the school without the prior permission of the Principal.
- 19. Catholic pupils are advised to go for confession at least once a month and every day for mass if possible.
- 20. It is mandatory to wear the prescribed school uniform daily by the students. Any additional item like the scarf, burqua, shawl and other objectionable gear are not permitted to be worn with the uniform in the school campus.
- 21. Students are not permitted either individually or in group to hold activities or worship, other than those organized by the school authority within the School Campus.
- 22. Books, Umbrellas, Tiffin-Carriers etc., should have a name or mark by which the owner can be easily known and all unclaimed articles should be brought to the Principal's Office.
- 23. No pupil is exempted from games, yoga and physical training without a medical certificate.
- 24. Students found cheating during examination, will not be allowed to answer the rest of the papers.
- 25. Students are not allowed to go to cinemas or picnics without the permission of their parents or guardians.
- NOTE: 1. Anybody going against the above rules will be issued warning cards by the Principal, after ONE reminder.
 - 2. Parents' whole-hearted co-operation is expected in these matters to maintain discipline and decorum in the school.

ATTENDANCE AND LEAVE RULES

- 1. Attendance adding up to 75% of the total number of working days is compulsory for all students.
- 2. Students should reach the school at least 10 minutes before the bell. Late comers will be marked PL (Present but Late).
- 3. Parents who are desirous of taking their children home during working hours (in case of emergency) should come in person and get the permission from the Principal by submitting a written request.
- Pupils must be punctual for class; those who come late or who have been absent on the previous day must bring the late attendance or absence record signed only by their parents.
- If the absence is for 2 or more working days or if it is during any test or Exam, he/she must obtain permission from the Principal and the permission will be granted only in authentic situations.
- Continuous absence for 15 days from school without permission will lead to the removal of the student's name from the school register. The school authorities will have full discretion in this matter.
- 7. Attendance is compulsory on the re-opening day, the last working day, on all the days of tests and examinations and all the days of State and National importance.
- 8. Extension of vacation by prefixing or suffixing leave is strictly prohibited. Absence before/after vacation or long holidays will be viewed very seriously. A fine of Rs. 200/- per day will be levied for days of absence before/after vacation or long holidays, if no prior permission is obtained by the parents from the Principal or if on return the parents do not justify the absence to the satisfaction of the Principal. This will

- apply in the case of all kinds of unauthorized absence at other times too.
- 9. A student returning to school after suffering from an infectious or contagious disease should produce a doctor's certificate permitting her to do so.

PARENTAL CO-OPERATION

- Parents are requested to co-operate with the school authorities in matters of discipline, regular hours of study at home and regular attendance at school. Tuitions are discouraged.
- 2. Parents should follow up the academic progress of their children with interest and meet the concerned teachers between 3.30 p.m. & 4.00 p.m. to ascertain from the teachers the conduct and progress of the students. They are requested not to enter the classrooms and see individual teachers during class hours, except on the day of Open House.
- Parents are requested not to allow their children to bring any money to school without the permission of the Principal except the money absolutely needed, for instance, for the bus, etc.
- 4. Parents should encourage their children to fully participate in all the co-curricular activities and the work experience drawn up by the school.
- 5. Students are not permitted to go to hotels and outside canteens for noon meals or snacks.
- 6. Payment of school fees for the whole year could be done before the commencement of the academic year. In case of inability to do so you are permitted to pay in two installments. The 2nd installment should be paid by the 30th of September.

- 7. Pupils who have not paid the fees will not be permitted to sit in the class or to answer their examination.
- 8. A written letter signed by the parent or guardian of the pupil is needed to send the pupil along with other persons' during school hours.
- 9. All communications from the school regarding home work, assignments, tests, exams, competitions, payment of fees etc will be sent to the parents through SMS and parent app. Parents are requested to download parent's app, check and follow them up. If parents do not receive such information regularly, they are requested to bring it to the notice of the Office Staff immediately.
- 10. Change of telephone nos. should be entered in the School Diary and brought to the notice of the office staff.
- 11. Parents are recommended to make use of the page set apart in this Diary for their own remarks.
- 12. Parents are requested not to allow children to bring CD's, iPods, Cameras, mobile phones, videogames or similar gadgets to the school. There will be surprise checking of students and their belongings and if a student is found with any of these gadgets, the same will be confiscated and returned only at the end of the year. Any violation of this rule will attract disciplinary action.
- 13. The teachers should not be criticized by the parents in the presence of students. Legitimate complaints should be brought to the notice of the Principal without delay. Anonymous letters/phone calls will not be considered.
- 14. Parents have a responsibility to encourage modest, decent dressing habits, conforming to acceptable social norms, amongst children from very early stages of their development.
- 15. Parents are expected to help their ward to improve academically by checking their progress reports after every evaluation
- 16. Parents will keep the child at home when suffering from contagious or infectious diseases.

LIBRARY AND COMPUTER CENTRE

Libraries and Computer Centre are two significant and integral components of the School. The school is equipped with a modernized library and computer centre. Students are expected to use them with great assiduousness and care, for their mental and intellectual growth.

Students shall co-operate with the Library and Computer Centre Staff, in maintaining order and restraint. Students shall take care not to lose, damage or destroy any of the materials, fixtures and equipments that are provided. Any loss or damage will have to be made good by the student concerned.

Students are expected to make use of the School Library to collect information to write their assignments. Marking, underlining and writing on the books is strictly not allowed. Dog-earing of the pages in the books is strictly forbidden.

 - a) Periodic Assessment
 - * Periodic Test
 - * Note Book Submission
 - * Subject Enrichment Activities
- b) Half Yearly and Yearly Written Exam
- Achievement Records/ Academic Performance: progress report has to be signed by the parent on the day of open house.
